INVESTIGATIVE PROGRAM | 3RD—5TH GRADE

Minimum: 25 students

Cost: \$16 per student

- Offered Tuesdays thru Fridays
- Students will receive an investigative portfolio, dissect flowers, learn how to be water wise, about pollination, study plant benefits, and composting with worms.
- Learn about Good Bugs and Bad Bugs
- Wagon ride thru the fields

ACTIVITIES

COMPOSTING PROGRAM

Our composting program teaches students the principles of recycling using worms as the “worlds greatest recycler”. Each composting session is taught by a Master Composter. Worms are a fun way for kids to learn about recycling and become more aware of the environment.

ART PROGRAM

Students will create a special “hands-on” art Project to take home.

MUSIC PROGRAM
